Jagoda Marinić is a writer, playwright and columnist. She writes for media including *Süddeutsche Zeitung*, *taz*, and *Deutsche Welle*. Marinić became known for her numerous award-winning novels, short stories, essays and plays.

For the programme of the Sibiu 2007 European Capital of Culture, Jagoda Marinić contributed the folk and station play *Zalina*, which was awarded the Excellence Award for Best Programme of the Capital of Culture Year.

Today she lives in Heidelberg, where she developed the *Interkulturelle Zentrum* and the nationally unique *International Welcome Center Heidelberg* for the city of Heidelberg.

She is on the board of the *Stiftung Internationale Wochen gegen Rassismus* and is involved in numerous advisory councils and juries, most recently with the Federal Cultural Foundation for *360°-Fonds für Kulturen der neuen Stadtgesellschaft*.

In spring 2019 her new book *Sheroes. Neue Held*innen braucht das Land* will be issued in which she explores current feminist debates and movements like #MeToo.
