



PROF. DR. JOCHEN SANDER

Prof. Dr. Jochen Sander has held the Städel Cooperation Professorship for Art History at Goethe University Frankfurt since 2008.

Working as a research associate at the Städel Museum in Frankfurt since 1988, he became deputy director of the Städel Museum in 2007 and head of the collection of pre-1800 German, Dutch and Flemish painting.

Prof. Dr. Jochen Sander has published numerous works, curated exhibitions and researched in the field of Dutch, German and Italian painting of the Middle Ages, the Early Modern Period and the Baroque. He is presently preparing the special exhibition Rembrandt. Creativity and Competition in Amsterdam 1630-1655 for the Städel Museum in Frankfurt and the National Gallery of Canada in Ottawa (2020-2021).
