Renate Schmidt has been an active member of the SPD since 1972. During her political career, she was Vice President of the German Bundestag between 1990 and 1994. In addition, from 2002 to 2005 she was Federal Minister for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth.

In the subsequent Bundestag under Angela Merkel's first term she was a member of the Committee for Education, Research and Technology Assessment.

Through various memberships and participations in charitable associations, such as *Gegen Vergessen – Für Demokratie e.V., Amcha Deutschland* and the board of trustees of the Documentation Center Nazi Party Rally Grounds of the City of Nuremberg, she demonstrates her voluntary commitment to the promotion of social and democratic structures.

Having grown up in Coburg, Fürth and Nuremberg, Renate Schmidt was made an honorary citizen of the city of Nuremberg in 2014.
